People have always wanted to create images of themselves: take for example the self-portraits of the great artists – Picasso and Van Gogh. There are numerous online competitions where our photos can collect likes from other people and become really popular.

Selfies have become a central part of people's lives and how we communicate with each other, and that's because they allow us to see a special world — our world.
